

Review of university-specific guidelines on editing theses

Introduction

Guidelines or policies on thesis editing were searched for each university in Australia using terms such as '[university name] thesis editing guidelines' or similar in early March 2018 to identify publicly available material. Material from each university has been saved as a PDF file and will be stored in the Guidelines Pod folder on Google Drive. Results are listed below with web links and dates where available, and comments on key features.

Of the 40 universities searched, 35 had publicly, easily available material on thesis editing.

Material from the 35 universities shows variation in publicly available material with a range of formats, content and references to the *Australian standards for editing practice* (ASEP) and/or the *IPEd Guidelines for editing research theses*, and/or current names such as Australian Council of Graduate Research or Deans and Directors of Graduate Studies, and IPEd or Council of Australian Societies of Editors. Formats include sections in official policies or procedures, sections in more informal student advice, or standalone policies. A university may have material in more than one place such as an official policy, and a list of resources, with different content. Length can vary from a one-line link to the IPEd website, one sentence or a separate three-page policy. Content varies in referring to ASEP and specific Parts in ASEP by letter or not, to the Guidelines by name or not and specific aspects of the Guidelines or not, and to the authors of these documents, with or without web links to these documents.

Table 1 shows variation in some content. This is not comprehensive but highlights variation.

Table 2 compares each university by specific features such as requiring hard copy editing. More features could be added, such as requiring acknowledgement of an editor's similar academic specialisation, giving definitions of copyediting and proofreading or referring to ACGR.
